Indonesia

On March 18, officials from IAPMO and PT IAPMO Group Indonesia visited more than 200 children at Yayasan Rahmatan Lil-Alamin orphanage, teaching them about the importance of plumbing, sanitation and water conservation in celebration of World Plumbing Day.

Shirley Dewi, Senior Vice President of PT IAPMO Group Indonesia, and Ken Wijaya, Executive Vice President of PT IAPMO Group Indonesia, delivered presentations at the event, which revolved around the World Plumbing Council's March 11 observance of World Plumbing Day and included a poster contest and coloring contest. The winners of the contest were announced during the event and were recognized during the fourth annual education conference commemorating World Plumbing Day on March 30 in Balai Kartini, Jakarta.

The purpose of the social event at the orphanage in Jakarta Timur was to provide education about the importance of good plumbing, sanitation and water conservation to young children, as they are the future generation and need to install good plumbing systems and adequate sanitation due to the limited amount of water that may be consumed by humans.

During the event, IAPMO Group CEO Russ Chaney announced the location of the 4th Annual Community Plumbing Challenge 2017 which will be held in the SD Negeri Cicau 02 school in Cicau Village, Bekasi, Indonesia. The event is scheduled to take place in November 2017.
