

Every Continent on Earth is impacted by water Scarcity


- Physical water scarcity inadequate water sources, ~20% of human population¹
- Economic water scarcity lack of investment in infrastructure $\sim 25\%$ of human population¹

Climate Change



Climate change is making our job more difficult

- Increasing droughts, more severe storms, flooding
- ~35% all wetlands disappeared between 1975 and 2015²
- Increased water vapor in the air creating feedback loop
- Displaced populations lacking water and food.
