

Full Statement for WPC Executive Board Nomination

I hold a professional background in water supply and drainage engineering, with over 30 years of working experience as a technical engineer. In 2008, I began engaging in industry governance work with the Plumbing Facilities Committee of the China Construction Metal Structure Association, serving as a specialist of the branch. From 2010 to 2016, I held the role of Chairman for a sub-network under the National Water Supply and Drainage Information Network. I officially joined the association in July 2017 and have since occupied multiple key leadership roles, accumulating in-depth expertise in industry governance, standardization development, and international industry exchanges.

My strong aspiration to serve as a Member of the WPC Executive Board stems from my long-standing commitment to the global plumbing sector, as well as my extensive experience in bridging China's plumbing industry with the international community. Our association has been an official member of the World Plumbing Council since 2002, representing China in global water industry initiatives for 24 years. Throughout this period, we have continuously organized Chinese enterprises to participate in successive editions of the World Plumbing Conference. In 2010, we hosted the launch press conference and series of promotional events for the inaugural World Plumbing Day in Beijing.
